**Photo Specs:**

Photos must be submitted in digital format and should be AT LEAST 452 px wide at 72 dpi; we will down-size larger images, but we cannot enlarge smaller images without losing image quality.

**Subject Matter:**

**Current photos-** We're looking for *fun*, unusual views, or current happenings taken along the canal or in canal communities.

**Historical images-** we prefer lesser known images or ones that have not been widely circulated or used in other publications.

**Required Caption:**

Submit photo with a one sentence caption; identify the place the photo was taken.

**Credit:**

Include a photographer credit at the end, e.g., (photo by: Jeff Curtis, 2012) or (photo courtesy: Rochester Historical Society)

**Photographer's Rights:**

Remember, these photos will be shared publicly on Facebook! We can't control where they may end up from there. Each photographer will retain all rights to any photograph submitted – including ownership if applicable – other than those rights licensed in the next sentence. By submitting an image, each photographer hereby grants to the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor (i) a nonexclusive, worldwide, irrevocable, royalty-free license to reproduce, distribute, publicly display the photographs submitted to the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor, and (ii) the right to use the photographer's name, city and state of residence in promotions and other publications.
